GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR ALL WORK TO BE DONE UNDER THIS PERMIT

(See Sections 5571.16 of the Ohio Revised Code)

Conditions herein following provide for Townships having authority over work covered in this permit within the Rights of Way on Township Roads.

The granting of this permit does not in any way abridge the right of the Township in its jurisdiction over township roads. If, in the process of any future work or for the benefit of the traveling public, it becomes necessary, in the opinion of Perkins Township to order the removal, reconstruction, relocation, or repair of any of the fixtures, or work performed under this permit, said removal, reconstruction, relocation, or repair shall be wholly at the expense of the owners thereof, and be made as directed by the Township Trustees.

The Public Works Director or designated representative shall act for and on behalf of the Township Trustees in the issuance of these permits. The carrying out of the provision of all Excavation and/or Public Works Use permits remains the responsibility of the respective governing authority.

The Director shall have full authority to ensure that the provisions of this permit are fully complied with; and retains the right to reject any materials or workmanship in the restoration of the Public Works facilities. Failure on the part of the permittee to conform to the provisions of this permit will be cause for suspension, revocation or annulment of this permit.

If the party or parties to whom this permit is issued does anything contrary to the orders of the Township and after due notice, fails to correct such work or to remove such structure or material as he or they may be ordered to remove, the Township may, with or without notice, correct such work or remove such structures or material; and the party or parties to whom this permit is issued shall reimburse the Township for any expenses incurred in correcting the work or removing the structure or materials.

All the work herein contemplated shall be done under the coordinated inspection of and to the satisfaction of the Township, and the entire expense thereof, shall be borne by the party or parties to whom this permit is issued.

Except as herein authorized, no excavation shall be made or obstacle placed within the limits of the highway in such a manner as to interfere with the travel over the road or the maintenance of the road.

If any grading or other work done under this permit interferes with the drainage of the highways in any way, such regrading, storm sewer pipe, catch basins, and outlets shall be constructed as may be necessary to take proper care of said drainage, all in accordance with the current Erie County storm drainage regulations currently in effect.

The acceptance of this permit OR the doing of any work thereunder shall constitute an agreement by the party or parties to whom the permit is granted, to comply with all of the conditions and restrictions printed or written herein.

All of the above conditions shall be applicable to the work herein authorized, unless the same is inconsistent with the conditions on the face of the permit, in which case the conditions written or printed on the face of the permit shall apply.

Highway property, disturbed by the permittee, shall be restored to its original condition as a minimum using materials, design and workmanship in conformance with the current edition of the ODOT Construction and Material Specifications as directed by the Township.

All work requiring men or vehicles on the pavement or shoulders shall comply with all of the requirements of the current version of the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways in effect at the time the permit is issued. Failure to comply with this requirement will be cause for immediate suspension of the permit by the responsible government agency until the proper traffic controls have been provided.

The permittee upon completion of the work shall leave the highway clean of all rubbish, excess materials, temporary structures, and equipment, and all parts of the highway shall be left in an acceptable condition.

The permittee shall save harmless the Township, and all of its respective representatives from all suits, actions, or claims of any character, brought on account of any injuries or damages sustained by any person or property in consequence of any neglect or on account of any act or omission as a result of the issuance of this permit. All work shall be performed in accordance with the OSHA Safety Standards.
